TENTH ANNUAL REUNION 1993

A full 2 days of activities began on Saturday with a boat trip from Portsmouth Harbor to the Isle of Shoals and a stay on Star Island for exploring and lunch.

A History of early Hampton was presented with slide illustrations by Mr. Harold Fernald who also showed how he brought history alive with hands-on field trips and projects with his high school classes covering archaeological digs and geology. He related all of this to Rev. Stephen Bachiler, and the 'time capsule' the students uncovered in Hampton near the Tuck Museum and Landing Road. Refreshments were served by several local volunteers including Rachel Sanborn and Priscilla Mills.

SUNDAY activities began at 9 a.m. at Luka's Green House Restaurant meeting rooms for member registration, coffee and Danish pastries. One hundred seven signed the guest book from 18 states, Canada and Germany. Tables with member volunteers provided centers for registration & hospitality, Genealogy, Memorabilia displays, Sales tables and several to display the donated gifts for the Scotch Auction.

From mid-morning to nearly 1 o'clock the meeting room was abandoned for a bus and auto tour arranged for and narrated by Richard B. Sanborn starting from the Hampton Falls High School. It proceeded

to Sanborn Corners, the early home of Dr. Charles Sanborn, now occupied by a Harrington Family. They welcomed visitors through this old homestead. The tour also viewed the birthplace of Frank B. Sanborn near by. He was a writer (biographer of Henry David Thoreau and many articles in the Atlantic Monthly and others), was a staunch abolitionist along with John Brown and his activities. Continuing, - the tour visited the Old School House, Bride's Hill, Meeting House Green, Tuck Museum, Pine Grove Cemetery and The Landing which is much the same as it was when the Sanborne brothers and Rev. Bachiler rowed up the New Hampshire coast in small open fishing dories from Massachusetts where they first landed in America.

The hungry busloads returned to Luka's for a large buffet, noisy conversations with periods of quieter noises of eating. This was followed by the perennial group photograph taken by Aurel Stuart of Manchester who has photographed the members at all ten of this societies reunions.

The business meeting was called to order at 2:35 p.m by the society President, Robert B. Sanborn who thanked the reunion committee of Richard B. Sanborn including Ruth and Robert MacPherson for their excellent planning and work.

A roll call by states was called and eighteen states responded: The largest numbers came from New Hampshire (30), Massachusetts (19), Maine (7) and the remainder (51) across the U.S. and Canada, 1 German visitor for a total of 105.

AWARDS were presented to Charles I. Garside, age 93 of Southbury, CT as the eldest person present. Bryan Flores (Robin Flores- mother and Charlie Sanborn- grandfather) received a certificate and pewter cup at age 5 for being the youngest present. Marc Frenzel, an Exchange Student from Germany travelled the farthest to attend the reunion and was given a can of Maple Syrup.

The following is a copy of the minutes of the **BUSINESS MEETING** obtained from the assistant secretary, Ruth S. Sanborn.

"President Robert B. Sanborn introduced Secretary Ruth MacPherson, Leominster, MA., who read the report of the 1992 Annual Reunion, held in Rutland, Vermont.

"President introduced Treasurer Ruth Sanborn Norcross, Arlington, MA., who gave the annual Treasurer's report.

"Arthur H. Sanborn, Candia, N.H., read the Report of the Auditor, Alice M. McDonald, Candia, N.H.

"President introduced Archivist Elizabeth Sanborn of Candia, N. H. who spoke of her display on the Memorabilia Table and also of several new items received today.

"President Robert Sanborn introduced The Sanborn Signatures Editor, Elmer C. Sanborn of Kalamazoo, MI., who spoke of work of the Publications Committee and welcomed articles for The Sanborn Signatures. He spoke of

the book Sanborns in America, copy on table here today waiting for approval of the Board for money. It will be printed by Gateway Press and sell for around \$23.00.

"President introduced George Sanborn, Derry, N.H., who reported on the English Research. George reported not a word from the Dutch Researcher in a year. The records in that part of Holland are very scanty. On the English Research, Michael Wood and Mrs. Mary Muncy, reported their project turned into a dead end. However, they are engaged in exploring other avenues, court records and parish records. Hope to have more to report next year.

"President introduced Genealogist Melinde Sanborn, Derry, N.H., who reported this year there was a division of labor, Elmer C. Sanborn working on Sanborn Records since 1800. She reported a quiet year working with Jonathan Sanborn of the Historical Society of New Hampshire on early records of Hawke, N.H., now Danville, N.H. Melinde reported after ten years and being the last member of the Original Board, she is now retiring.

"President Robert Sanborn called for the Report of the Nominating Committee.

"Report of the Nominating Committee was presented by Arthur H. Sanborn, Candia, N. H., as follows:

"Nominations from the floor called for. Elmer Sanborn presented the name of Richard D. Carleton of Wisconsin for Vice President.

"Sanborn Partridge moved to leave the election of the Genealogist to the Board. Motion seconded by George Sanborn.

"In searching the by-laws, it was noted this office should be filled by vote of the meeting.

"Sanborn Partridge withdrew his motion and moved the Genealogist be elected now. Motion seconded by Arthur H. Sanborn.

"Motion of Betty Sanborn that Elmer C. Sanborn be elected Genealogist. Motion seconded by Sanborn Partridge. It was a vote in the affirmative and so declared.

"The remaining list of officers as presented by the Nominating Committee put to vote, with the exception of the Vice President where there is a choice, as follows:

Secretary Ruth MacPherson
Asst. Sec'y. Ruth S. Sanborn
Treasurer Ruth S. Norcross

It was a vote in the affirmative and so declared.

"Richard B. Sanborn took over for the election of the Vice President. As there were 2 nominations, Richard Sanborn called for a show of hands vote.

Robert B. Sanborn received 24 votes
Richard D. Carleton received 27 votes

and Richard D. Carleton having a plurality of votes cast was declared elected Vice President.

"This concluded the voting.

"At this time Robert B. Sanborn turned the gavel over to our new President Richard B. Sanborn with congratulations.

"Drawing for the V.C. Sanborn Genealogy was conducted by Secretary Ruth MacPherson. Charles I. Garside drew the number and the lucky winner was Priscilla S. Watts, Deerfield, N.H.

"President Richard B. Sanborn called for a brief meeting of the Board of Directors immediately following this meeting.

"The Scotch Auction to benefit the Sanborn Scholarship Fund was held at this time. Much credit for the way this fast moving auction was handled goes to Richard Norcross, Ruth MacPherson, Irene Crowley, Barbara Gulliver and Mr & Mrs. Lester Peterson.

"President Richard Sanborn called for any other business to come before the meeting.

"A rousing round of applause was given to retiring President Robert B. Sanborn.

"Secretary Ruth MacPherson thanked Reunion Chairman Richard Sanborn and stated that it was Richard who had worked out and planned this most enjoyable two day Reunion. Members are still talking about that delightful trip to the Isles of Shoals and that most enjoyable illustrated lecture on the History of Earlier Hampton given by Mr. Harold Fernald. A big round of applause was given to Richard Sanborn.

"In closing we were led by Ellen Merriam and Al Sanborn in singing the Sanborn Farewell Song written by Betty Sanborn, Candia, N.H.

BOARD DECIDES NOT TO PUBLISH BOOK.

The following is a summary of the activities surrounding a proposal to make available to the membership in book form, the inter-related lineage records which they have submitted to the SFA over the past nine years.

In the 1993 annual reunion announcement mailed last July to members of the Sanborn Family Association was a notice of a forthcoming publication of Genealogies of Sanborns in America, 1899-1993. Interested members were asked to let the compiler, Elmer Sanborn of Kalamazoo, Michigan, know how many copies they would like. The book would consist of a computerized version of information supplied by Association members on the blank lineage forms sent to all new members, and these would be keyed, wherever possible, to numbered individuals in the 1899 genealogy of the family.

Publisher's quotes to do the job were obtained. There were enough expressions of interest (over 350) to pay for the book (assuming those who said they were interested actually paid).

A full discussion of this proposal occurred at a Board meeting held immediately after the 1993 annual reunion. The Board listened to an analysis of the project presented by George F. Sanborn Jr., founding member of the Association, first president, and a well-known genealogist. His opinion was strongly in favor of NOT publishing this book. Moreover, the opinion of Melinde Lutz Sanborn, retiring Genealogist of the Association and a founding member of the organization, was that she was also strongly opposed to the board's sponsorship of this book. Their reasons were that: 1) sales of this book would undermine sales of a fully revised and updated family genealogy which is one of the goals of the association and which has been planned from the start; 2) people might wrongly assume the published lineages book was in fact the revised genealogy.

The Board therefore did not support sponsorship and publication of the book under the Association's name. Work on the revision and update of the 1899 genealogy by Victor C. Sanborn remains a stated objective of the Sanborn Family Association. But no plans to accomplish this have been stated.

LEONARD FOGG SANBORN age 89 of Kingston, NH died 6 August 1993. He was born 20 October 1903 in East Hartland, CT, the son of Edward and Martha (Pike) Sanborn. He had been employed as a civil engineer for the Fay-Spoffard and Thorndike Company of Boston, retiring in 1971. He was also employed by the Hamilton Engineering of Nashua as a director, retiring in 1980. He was a new Hampshire State Representative from 1972-1978 and was named "Citizen of the Year" in Kingston and was a long term moderator there. Mr. Sanborn was active in genealogy and descended back through 6 generations of Sanborns to **Tristram Sanborn** born in Kingston in 1684. His wife, Dorothy (Rae) Sanborn died in 1990. He is survived by 3 sons, **Philip M. Sanborn** of Lee, **E. Charles Sanborn** of Pembroke and **Donald P. Sanborn** of South Hampton; 2 daughters, Judith Levis of East Kingston and Dorothy Elizabeth Blank of Miami, FL; 21 grandchildren; several nieces and nephews.

GEORGE DUTTON, husband of **Eva (Sanborn) Dutton** died 17 August 1993 in Temple, NH. George and Eva were long time residents of Carlisle, MA raising a family of 4 girls and 1 boy. George was employed at a Carlisle Dairy and later years as custodian at the Carlisle Library where Eva was also employed as a librarian worker. Eva died 2 Jan 1986, she was an aunt to E.C. Sanborn and Edgar F. Sanborn, Jr. Eva and George are buried in the Congregational Church cemetery in Carlisle. They are survived by their children, Barbara Thorensen of West Yarmouth, MA; Marilyn E. Taylor of Avon, CT; Beverly F. Dutton of Tucson, AZ; and Glen W. Dutton of Pelham, NH.; a brother, Raymond Dutton of Hudson, MA and the late Mabel L. Bates, Francis H. Dutton, Warren E. BARBARA ELIZABETH (SANBORN) LEWIS, age 64 of Lauderhill, FL died 27 April 1993 of leukemia. She was born in Hartford, CT the daughter of **Reginald Ware Sanborn** (b. 1893 in Spencer, MA descended from William

Sanborne) and Irene Whittemore (b. in Leicester, MA) who is a descendant of Dr. Rufus Cowles, a founder of Amherst College. Barbara attended Ohio University 1946-1948. Her husband, John David Lewis died 7 July 1971. She is survived by 5 children: Timothy Sanborn Lewis of Coral Springs, FL; Mary Lynn (Lewis) Southall of N. Lauderdale; Mary Elizabeth Lewis; Jeffrey David Lewis; and Laurie Christina (Lewis) Seabrook of Sunrise, FL; a brother **Frederic Cowles Sanborn** of Ohio; a sister **Marilyn (Sanborn) Myers** of Pennsylvania; another sister **Jeanette Whittemore (Sanborn) Pfeiffer** died 4 July 1965 in Akron, OH.

JEAN AGNES (MACALLISTER) SANBORN age 82, a long time resident of Tilton, NH died 31 Aug 1992 in Evergreen, CO. A native of Sherbrook, Quebec, Canada, she moved to Tilton, NH as a young girl. In 1938 she married **Floyd¹⁰ Francis Sanborn**, a conductor for the Boston and Maine Rail Road. He died in 1984. She was a member of the Lochmere Woman's Club and the O.E.S. in Franklin. Family members include her daughter, Linda Posson of Evergreen, CO and 2 granddaughters, Geneve Posson and Kristen Posson of Blacksburg, VA.

MARY (CUTTER) SANBORN, age 79 of Hopkinton, NH died after a brief illness in Concord. Born in Lawrence, MA, she moved to Winchester, MA in 1923. She was a graduate of Winchester High School and Sargent College in Cambridge, MA. She earned her bachelor's degree in 1936 from Jackson College in Boston and her master's degree in medical technology from Simmons College. She was a laboratory technologist at Faulkner Hospital, Jamaica Plains, MA until 1943 and worked at Winchester Hospitals in Winchester from 1943 to 1945. An avid tennis player, Mary won more than 50 tennis trophies, her last in 1968. She advanced to the quarterfinal round in national girls competition in 1930. She was a member of the Concord Autobahn Society. She was married for 38 years to **Robert¹⁰ Ellard Sanborn** who died in 1984. Family members include 3 sons, **Fredrick C. ROGER A. SANBORN, age 76 died 8 Dec 1992 at his home in Rumney, NH. Mr. Sanborn was a graduate of Plymouth High School, a veteran of the U.S. Air Force in World War II, and a member of the Rumney American Legion. Family members include his wife, **Mary (Murdough) Sanborn** of Rumney; 2 sons, **Douglas** and **Greg Sanborn**, both of Rumney; one daughter, **Sandra Poitras**.

RALPH¹⁰ ELLIOT SANBORN age 90, a resident of Wales, ME, died April 13, 1993 at his home. Ralph was born in Wales, 8 April 1903, the son of **Albert J. and Olive (Beal) Sanborn**. He attended Sabattus High School and the Auburn School of Commerce. He married **Myra E. Jordan** 28 Aug 1928 in Seal Harbor, ME. She died 24 Aug 1950. "Johnnie Come Lately"

What were some of the English Sambourne families like? Numerous families of Sambournes are given in V.C. Sanborn's family history whose lineages have never been directly linked to Anne Bachiler and her three sons, Stephen, John and William Samborne.

Although it is generally believed that Sanborns in America have descended from the three grandsons of Rev. Stephen Bachiler, Stephen, John and William Samborne, there is a nagging question "why didn't some of the English Sambourne's subsequent to the initial, 1640 emigration, come to the "colonies" and produce lines here separate from those of the three brothers?" It's possible there were, but few have been documented as such. Is it something to watch for when tracing Sanborn lines now?

One Edward Mott Sambourne, a London merchant, and **his brother and sister were all born in Easton, PA, USA.**¹ When or why he left England, nor when his family returned to England, are not recorded. This Edward Mott was born 23 May 1802. His son, Edward Linley Sambourne (1844-1910), however, was educated back in London city's Schools and Chester Colleges, where he studied engineering and subsequently worked for the engineering firm of John Penn and Son in Greenwich, 1861-1867, followed by a career change to cartoonist for "Punch" in 1867 where he remained, well known as a designer, draftsman, and artist.

Their lineage is given on page 47 in V. C. Sanborn Text¹ under "Scattered Notes on English Sambornes". It doesn't seem to connect to our current "Stephen-John-William" line. Precedents of the Linley line were reported in "The Godfather" by Christopher Warwick which appeared in the British magazine Majesty, in the fall issue 1989, volume 9, no. 10, pp 15-19. Here a suggested connection of this Linley line is made to the English Royal Family.

A well-written article by Sophia Dembling² was the seed from which this present article is nurtured. The Victorian style and how it is preserved in one museum is fun reading, especially when it also adds genealogy information. This latter is incorporated in the lineage chart at the end. The reporting in the original article can't be improved upon for our purposes here and so it is reprinted, in toto, with permission of the Dallas (Texas) Morning News.

"Victorian Excesses Remain in Linley Sambourne House

"LONDON -- In the 19th century, Queen Victoria tried desperately to stifle all traces of sensuality in her adoring subjects (those were the days when even piano legs were demurely clothed). But human nature is not so easily denied, and what was lost in direct expression spilled out in other ways.

Like the plump curves, ruffled bloomers and elaborate manners depicted in Victorian erotica - - which flourished during the prudish queen's reign -- the decor of the era was excessive, indulgent and overwrought.

The Linley Sambourne House, maintained by the Victorian Society is a perfect example of such style.

Linley Sambourne was an illustrator and a political cartoonist for the fashionable magazine *Punch* --sort of the Spy of its day (and still in publication). Married (Marion Herapath - ed.) in 1874, Mr. Sambourne, his bride and his mother (Frances Linley -ed.) moved into the London town house and promptly, says a museum docent, "furnished it with all the stuff a young, ambitious, upwardly mobile couple could want".

After Mr. Sambourne's death in 1910 and his wife's in 1914, the house was left to their son, Mawdley Herapath Sambourne- always known as Roy.

"Roy was a troublesome child," says the docent, "who never did anything much." Certainly not to the house in which he lived all his life. When the Victorian Society compared the contents of the house to an 1877 inventory, it was revealed that Roy never so much as emptied furniture drawers of his parents' possessions.

After Roy's death in 1946 the house passed to his sister Maude Frances (Sambourne), then to her daughter Lady Rosse, both of whom lovingly maintained it nearly exactly as it was left by the Sambournes. (Lady Rosse's bedroom is the only room that has been redecorated.) The Earl and Countess of Rosse lived in the house for 22 years before selling it and its contents to the Greater London Council in 1980 to be opened to the public as a museum.

In true Victorian Style, there is not an inch of empty wall space or a surface uncluttered with the sort of knickknacks that were so dear to Victorian hearts. Photos, vases, books, clocks, fans, mirrors, porcelain and statuettes - many of nude or scantily clad women -- vie for space. Windows are stained glass or shrouded in fussy blinds, drapes or lace curtains; the grandfather clock sternly warns "Tempus Fugit"; lamps wear fringes, chairs and sofas wear throw pillows.

And when the Sambournes -- whose income was respectable but not tremendous -- could not afford original art, they framed photographs cut out of magazines. Beyond and beneath it all,

elaborately patterned wallpapers and rugs add to the visual racket.

Although Mr. Sambourne would have been hard-pressed to buy artworks of the popular artists of his day, he counted among his friends people such as Kate Greenaway and Sir John Tenniel (*Punch's* pre-Sambourne political cartoonist and illustrator of the classic "Alice in Wonderland"). These and other artists made him gifts of artwork that can be found on the crammed walls. A fireplace fan in Lady Rosse's bedroom is decorated and signed by many of the era's fashionable artists.

In the entry hall hang originals of Mr. Sambourne's cartoons, their political messages obscured by the passage of time. In the downstairs bathroom, walls are covered with photographs taken by Mr. Sambourne to be used for reference.

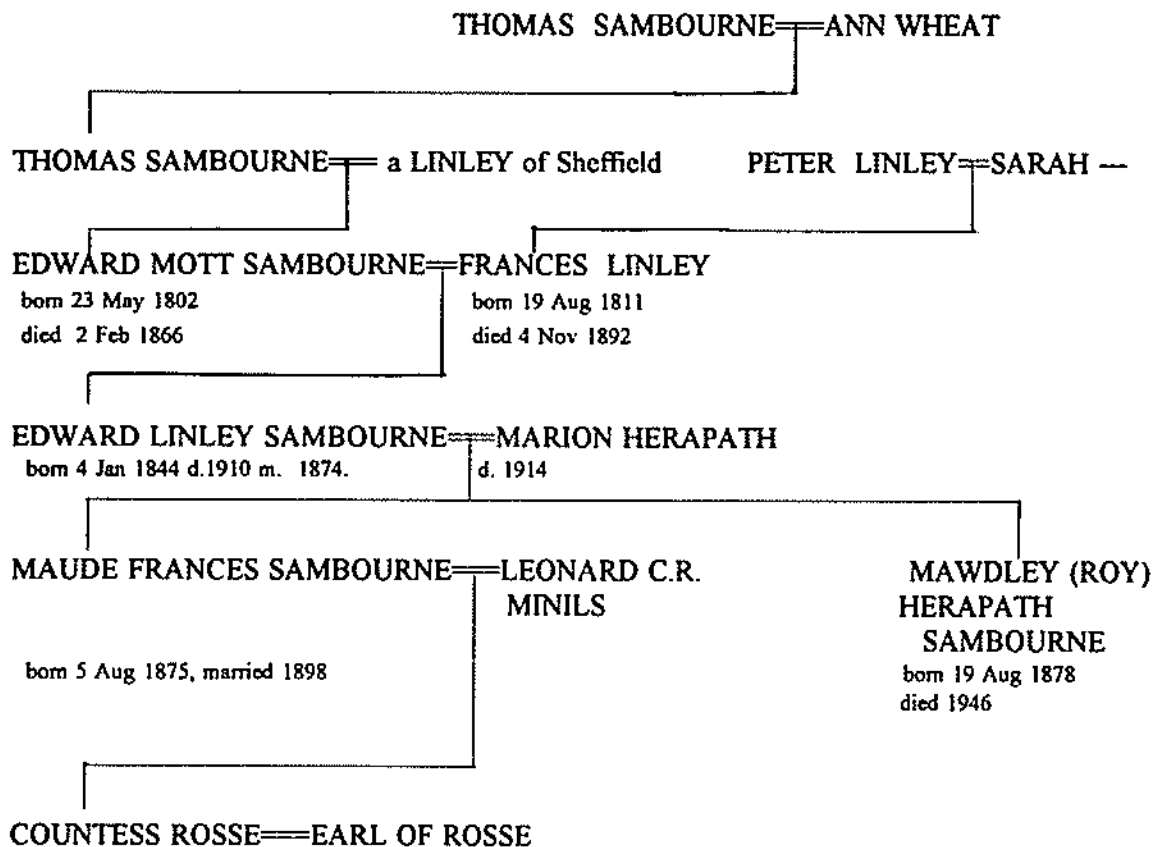
These, the museum catalog deadpans, "give some idea of his skill and versatility as a photographer", but in truth are delightfully ridiculous -- the walrus-mustachioed Mr. Sambourne in a variety of poses that were surely useful to the artist needing to draw a person in action, but are simply silly out of context.

Roy's room, which the catalog says "preserves a flavour of Edwardian bachelordom," includes photographs of girlfriends and signed photographs of Edna Mae and other actresses. Roy was quite the man about town in his youth.

After Victoria and the Victoriana of her era, England was ruled by Edward VII and opulent but more restrained Edwardian style. Then came World War I, industrialization and the irrevocable world changes that have led up to today -- an era that no doubt would shock Queen Victoria right out of her unmentionables.

The Linley Sambourne House is a moment frozen in her time.

THE BY-LAWS OF
THE SANBORN FAMILY ASSOCIATION 1990

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the corporation shall be The Sanborn Family Association.

ARTICLE II - Purpose

The purpose of this Association shall be research, communication, and publication in the field of genealogy, with special attention devoted to the ancestors and descendants of John, William and Stephen Samborne, the sponsoring of family reunions from time to time, and anyother such purposes allowed under the laws and rules of a non-profit corporation in the State of New Hampshire.

ARTICLE III - Eligibility

Descendants of John, William and Stephen Samborne, who settled in Hampton, New Hampshire in 1638, and other interested persons shall be elibigle to membership in this Association.

ARTICLE IV - Officers

Section 1: The officers of the Association shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Genealogist and Archivist.

Section 2: The officers shall be elected by vote of the members present at the Annual Meeting, except that the Archivist shall be appointed by the President with the approval of the Executive Board.

Section 3: The officers shall be elected for a one-year term, with the option of re-election each succeeding year, except that the Archivist shall serve at the pleasure of the Executive Board.

Section 4: The duties of the officers shall be those usually per-taining to their respective offices and as defined by the Executive Board, and shall include the following:

- a) The President shall preside at all meetings of the Association and of the Executive Board. The President shall appoint the Chairmen and the members of all com-mittees, with the advice and consultation of the Execu-tive Board members. The President shall name the Nominating Committee, which is responsible for nominating officers of the Association.
- b) The Vice-President shall assume responsibility for the functions assigned to him.

- c) The Treasurer shall receive and account for all funds of the Association and shall pay the normal operating bills of the Association. Any expenditures of capital funds must be authorized and approved by the Executive Board. The Treasurer shall submit a complete annual financial report for the Association at the Annual Meeting. Included with this financial report shall be an audit report prepared by an Auditor or Audit Committee appointed by the Executive Board annually.
- d) The Secretary shall keep membership records and an up-to-date mailing list at all times. In addition, the Secretary shall answer correspondence and keep the Minutes of the Executive Board Meetings and the Annual Business Meeting. He or she shall prepare and send to all Executive Board members sufficient notice before each meeting of the time and place thereof, and shall distribute a typed copy of the Minutes of each meeting to the Executive Board Members in a timely fashion after each meeting. In addition, the Secretary shall perform such other duties as from time to time may seem appropriate in the normal course of events. The Secretary shall keep the Association's permanent records.
- e) The Genealogist shall gather and organize genealogical details on members of the Sanborn Family for preservation in the Association's permanent archives. He or she shall enlist the support and assistance of others to this end.
- f) The Assistant Secretary shall assist the Secretary as from time to time may be necessary in the duties as set forth above, as well as assisting the Secretary in any research he or she is unable to complete in answering letters of inquiry.
- g) The Archivist shall maintain the Association's non-current permanent records and archives.

ARTICLE V - Membership and Dues

Section 1: Any person meeting the eligibility requirements of Article III may become a member of The Sanborn Family Association.

- a) Members shall pay regular annual dues as established by the Executive Board.
- b) The membership year shall be determined by the Executive Board. Membership dues paid late in the membership year shall be for the full amount, and back issues of newsletters for that membership year will be mailed to the new members.
- c) Life Members shall pay a single one-time membership fee, the amount to be determined from time to time by the Executive Board.
- d) Honorary Members may be elected at any Annual Meeting from the lists of members and Life Members; and upon election shall be relieved of payment of any dues.

Section 2: Members from whom current dues have not been received, and who do not reply to renewal notices by March 1st, shall be placed on the inactive list and will no longer be sent notices and newsletters.

ARTICLE VI - The Executive Board

Section 1: The Executive Board shall consist of not fewer than seven members and shall be comprised of elected officers and of committee chairmen. Appointed Executive Board Members shall serve for a term of up to 3 years, such that the term of one or more such members shall expire each year, except that the Archivist shall serve at the pleasure of the Executive Board.

Section 2: The Executive Board shall have the authority to fill any vacancies in its membership which may occur between Annual Meetings.

Section 3: The Executive Board, during the interval between meetings, shall have the authority to take any action for the Association.

ARTICLE VII - Meetings

Section 1: The Association shall hold an Annual Meeting in the month of August. Notification of the date and location of the Annual Meeting shall be given in either the Association's newsletter or in a special notice mailed to the membership. Notification of the Annual Meeting shall be mailed out not less than six weeks prior to the date of the meeting. Special meetings of the Association may be held with reasonable notice being given.

Section 2: The Executive Board shall hold meetings as called by the President of the Association upon due notice to the Board members. Meetings may be an assemblage or by telephone conference call.

ARTICLE VIII - Amendments

These By-Laws may be altered, amended, or repealed by a majority vote of the Association at any Annual Meeting.

ARTICLE IX - Parliamentary Procedure

In general, meetings of the Association shall follow standard Parliamentary Procedure. In case of dispute, reference shall be made to the most recent edition of Roberts' Rules of Order, Revised. The President may designate a Parliamentarian to advise and assist him in the interpretation of Parliamentary Procedure.
