ANOTHER CANADIAN CONNECTION

In these days of melting borders, it may not seem strange to us to realize that just after the American Revolution, many of our New England relatives crossed over the border into Canada and established primarily English-speaking settlements in Quebec, called the Eastern Townships. More than a few with Sanborn blood made this pioneering move, including one Isaac⁶ Sanborn, in whose line V.C. Sanborn got no closer than his parents, Josiah⁵ and Susanna (Waldron) Sanborn of Warner, NH.

This unnoticed Isaac Sanborn was married three times, had at least thirteen children, and is the ancestor of several of our Sanborn Family Association members. It is through the courtesy of member Florence Rollins Sanborn, that we are able to print a photograph of Isaac Sanborn and his second wife, Elizabeth Drown, below.

Jonathan TIBBETTS and had, at least, Frank L. Tibbetts, b. 2 Nov 1839. VCS does not indicate any wife Betty Cook for any Moses listed nor does it list any Hannah born on the stated date. All references in Sawyer's HISTORY OF KENSINGTON refer to Hannah as the daughter of Betty Cook, not Betty SANBORN. Can anyone shed light on this? Gary T. A CORRECTION FROM HAWAII

In the Spring 1988 SANBORN SIGNATURES, in an article entitled "Sanborns in Mexico," I gave Israel Sanborn and Sally Cheever (VCS #200) as my great-great-great-grandparents and progenitors of Walter and Frank who founded the Sanborns stores in the Republic of Mexico. I have recently learned my information was incorrect. Israel and Sally's John (1802-1820, unmarried) could not have been my ancestor. It turns out he was actually Dr. John Sanborn (b. Dec 1810/Jan 1811 in VT according to 1850 census) who married Caroline Harrington before 1837 in Caledonia Co. and d. 30 Apr 1855, Hardwick, VT according to Maple Street Cemetery records. I am still searching for the parents of this John Sanborn and would appreciate help from my Sanborn cousins in finding them. I apologize for any inconvenience my error may have caused anyone. (The error is mine, I humbly regret that I don't always get these things right, either. -MLS)


